ORDER

Sanction is hereby accorded to the enhancement of remuneration instead of TA/DA to the staff deputed for election work during elections to the Panchayats/Urban Local Bodies on the analogy of scheme adopted by the State Government for the conduct of elections to the State Legislature/Parliament on the pattern of Election Commission of India letter No. 464/INST/2009/eps, Dated 9th January, 2009 as under :-

2. The above rates are also applicable to the staff for attending training classes, collecting polling materials, etc., and also for attending duty on the polling day. Attendance of training for elections is counted as a separate day.

3. The staff deployed at all polling stations/counting centers shall be provided with packed lunch and /or light refreshment at the rate of Rs.100/- per head per day. In case of difficulty in providing packed lunch a cash payment of Rs.100/- per head shall be made.

Please ensure that in future, remuneration instead of TA/DA to staff deputed for polling/counting duty, attending training classes and distributing/collecting polling materials in respect of Panchayat/Urban Local Bodies elections will be regulated according to above sanction. No traveling charges will be paid separately.

3. These instructions will not be applicable to staff deputed for election duty pertaining to collection of election material from the Commission's office/Election Department, Printing Presses etc. printing of voter's lists, ballot papers, receiving nomination papers and other works except as mentioned in the above sanction, in which case TA/DA as per Haryana Government instructions will be paid.

4. Accordingly, the demand for payment of remuneration instead of TA/DA may be sent to the commission before every General/Bye-election well in time in order to ensure payment on the spot after completion of election process at the time of issuance of relieving chit.
